

NEW TRUSTEES APPOINTED TO WEXNER CENTER FOUNDATION BOARD

At its meeting on October 16, 2007, the Wexner Center Foundation board appointed two new trustees: Elizabeth Kessler of the law firm Jones Day and James Lyski of Nationwide.

Lyski graduated from the University of Oregon with an M.B.A. and a bachelor's degree in journalism.
